AREA "HERITAGE" BUS TOUR
Depart for Bucks County PA and Washington Crossing, where George Washington crossed the Delaware River. Then, to Doylestown to tour the historic Moravian Tile works, seeing how tiles were made 100 years ago. Opportunity to walk the quaint town of Doylestown. Then to New Hope, PA for lunch, either along the Delaware River or aboard the New Hope and Ivyland Railroad. Enjoy an hour's ride on that historic railroad – an authentic, restored steam engine, cars. Following the train ride and lunch, ride the bus (or walk) across the Bridge to the NJ side of the Delaware River to Lambertville. Enjoy antique stores for browsing (maps provided) in a very compact town with antique stores and galleries located within 2-3 blocks of Main Street. A great opportunity to hunt for treasures you have always been looking for.
